original Lincoln or two from the '70s, '80s, or '90s. A stop at Unique Classic Cars in Mankato, MN quickly fulfilled that request. Ralph and Jan selected a white 1977 Mark V with only 15,000 miles and a dark cherry 2007 Signature Series Town Car with ivory trim. The Town Car has only 50,000 miles.
